## **Online Home Repair Registration Form**

Thank you for your interest in Habitat for Humanity of Lenawee County's home repair program. Through a variety of grant partnerships, we provide funding for home repairs with a focus on critical repairs necessary to safely remain in the home. Our repairs program is designed to assist low to moderate income residents of Lenawee County.

If you are interested in assistance with home repairs, please read and complete the following documents and submit to Habitat for Humanity of Lenawee County – 1043 E. US-223, Adrian MI, 49221 or email to <u>wknox@habitat-lenawee.org</u>.

- The property must be owner-occupied, the primary residence for a minimum of 6 months, and located in Lenawee County
- The property must be in need of repairs or maintenance:
  - Roof, windows, insulation, furnace, hot water heater, etc. (Complete list of qualifying repairs pg.4)
  - Accessibility/disability modifications are eligible
  - Flooring, painting and other cosmetic changes are not eligible
- Homeowner(s) must be either a U.S. citizen or a Permanent Legal Resident
- Only owner-occupied 1-4 family homes, condominiums, townhomes, and manufactured housing deeded as Real Estate are eligible. Land contracts, mobile homes, homes used as rental units and dwellings that are not the primary residence of the applicant are not eligible.
- Household must be willing to complete sweat/social equity (data and document collection, volunteer work, be on site for repairs, clean up/move any items in home as required before repairs).
- Homeowner(s) must be current with the following:
  - Mortgage loan payment (if the homeowner is still making payments)
  - Homeowner's insurance policy
  - o Property taxes

Household income must be below 80% of the area median income (AMI) for Lenawee County, as indicated in the chart at right.

## Things You Need To Know:

- This form is <u>not an application</u>. It is a Registration Form used to collect information about your household and your repair needs. This step must be taken in order to be placed on the list to receive an application when they become available.
- If the repair you are seeking to get is not on the list of qualified repairs, then we are not able to help with that specific repair.
- In order to be eligible for the repair program, you **must** own your home, be current on mortgage payments and be current on taxes and insurance. Land Contracts are not eligible for repairs.
- At this time, Habitat of Lenawee's repair program opens in the spring when funding is released. Funding for repairs are determined by the Federal Home Loan Bank. When funding runs out, money allocated for grants is exhausted for the remainder of the year.
- Grant money is money given by organizations that does not need to be paid back. The grants offered through Habitat of Lenawee are the Neighborhood Impact Program (NIP), HFHLC Critical Repair, and HFHLC Aging and Accessibility Grant.
- NIP has a maximum grant allowance of \$15,000.
- Habitat Lenawee's Critical Repair grant has a maximum of \$10,000 and Aging and Accessibility is \$10,000.
  - These allowances are subject to change and are not guaranteed from year to year. Applicants will be notified at time of applying if these amounts have changed.
- If the repair you are looking to get, costs MORE than the grant money covers, you will have to provide proof that you are able to cover the remaining balance or we will not be able to accept your application as complete.
- Applications are expected to be sent out in April. However, we will allow applications to continue to be sent out until the funding is exhausted.
- Upon receiving an application, you will be required to obtain at least 2 quotes from <u>Licensed Contractors</u>. It is very important to ask for a copy of this license because, if you do not have a copy, your quote will not be complete. (In some cases the contractor feels more comfortable sending this document directly to Habitat)
- Quotes and Financial Documents that exceed 30 days from the day the application is submitted cannot be accepted and will have to be updated.

The following repair/replacement of existing elements are eligible for funding:

## **ELIGIBLE DEFERRED MAINTENANCE REPAIRS**

- HVAC systems and ductwork
- Siding
- Well or septic systems
- Roof and/or chimney
- Water Heater
- Gutters and downspouts
- Windows
- Exterior doors (including overhead garage)

- Soffit and Fascia
- Insulation or weatherization
- Electrical
- Ceiling and drywall repair (due to roof failure)
- Structural repairs foundations and floor joists
- Plumbing Sump-pump systems
- Basement/Crawlspace Waterproofing

## THE FOLLOWING ACCESSIBILITY & SAFETY REPAIRS ARE ALSO AVAILABLE

- Entry Ramps
- Entry Steps/Stairs
- Mold and/or mildew remediation
- Levered door handles
- Interior/Exterior handrails
- Widened doorways

- Internal Chair or Wheelchair lifts
- Relocation of washer/dryer from basement to main level of the home
- Installation of walk-in shower
- ADA height toilets and fixtures
- Grab bars
